Additionally, the family will receive mosquito nets to lower the risk of contracting malaria and Certeza - water purifying liquid to make sure Heminia and her children drink healthy water.

As a measure to eliminate the risk of property grabbing, HFH Mozambique also makes it mandatory for all families receiving a home to be trained and successfully write a will which is a detailed succession plan in the event of death of a caregiver. This document is legally recognized in Mozambique and ensures safe future of the children.

Heminia is a widow. Her husband died of HIV/AIDS. She is taking care of her two sons, Jose and Pascoal and her granddaughter Alegria.

Heminia works on a farm and Jose helps her out while Pascoal and Alegria are at school.

Their house is made of thatch, reed and mud and is in a very bad state.
